

GROUP PD

Special stamps used only for collecting Postage Due

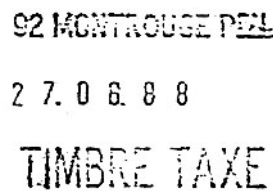
There are two specific sub-groups, those used to collect short-paid postage, and those used to collect a fee charged on general delivery (poste restante) mail held at the post office for pickup.

Stamps used to collect postage due on short paid mail *SUB-GROUP PD-A*

PD-A1 1984, Satas (MV). As Type AA9 with tall date figures but with "TIMBRE TAX" replacing the meter number at bottom. TM: SC..... 50¢
V/F: ★000



PD-A2 1988, Frama (MV). As Type PO-B7B with "TIMBRE TAXE" as the bottom line of the town mark. With or without hour figure between date and frank. Known printed in red and in black.
A. M# with "S1" prefix below "POSTES". V/F: 0000 .. \$15
B. Without M#. V/F: 00000 50¢



PD-A3 1987, SMH-ALCATEL (MV). As Type AA5 but with "TIMBRE TAXE" replacing the meter number at bottom. Printed in black..... \$10
V/F: ★00



NOTES: Frama Post Office stamp Type PO-B7B was used as a Postage Due stamp as early as 1986 with hand stamp "Timbre Taxe" applied.

Meter T87323 of Type AA5G was used in Nancy between 1985 and 1990 for Postage Due by use of the slogan shown at right.

SUB-GROUP PD-B

PD-B1 1958, Havas (FV). AS Type AA5C but with "POSTE RESTANTE" in the bottom of the TM. M# M.8001..... \$75

Value: 15F

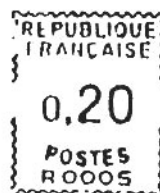
PD-B2 1961, Havas (FV). Frank with bar below "POSTES". TM is below the frank rather than at the left. TM contains "POSTE RESTANTE" at bottom \$100

Value: 0,20



PD-B3 1963, Havas (FV). Similar to Type PD-B2 but with M# below "POSTES". M# with "R", "PR" or "R1" prefix. TM below frank with "POSTE RESTANTE" at bottom.

- Values: 0,20 (M# with "R" prefix)..... \$40
- 0,30 (M# with "R" prefix)..... \$20
- 0,40 (M# with "PR" prefix)..... \$20
- 0,70 (M# with "R1" prefix)..... \$15
- 1,00 (M# with "R1" prefix)..... \$15



PD-B4 1978, Havas (FV). As Type PD-B3 but with "TAXEPR" replacing the figure of value. M# with "R1" prefix. TM below frank with "POSTE RESTANTE" at bottom \$1
