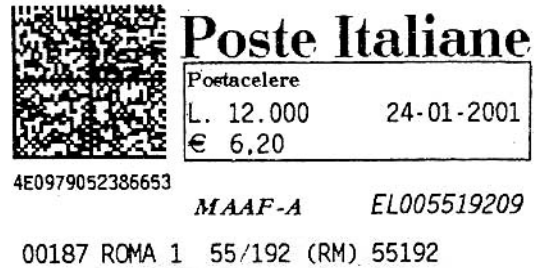


**PO16** 2001, "Zebra" (digital). Similar to Type PO15 with large, square digital data field but with "Poste Italiane" at top above box containing value figures and date. One seen from 2001 with dual value figures in Lira and Euros. Presumably later examples without Lira value figures exist.

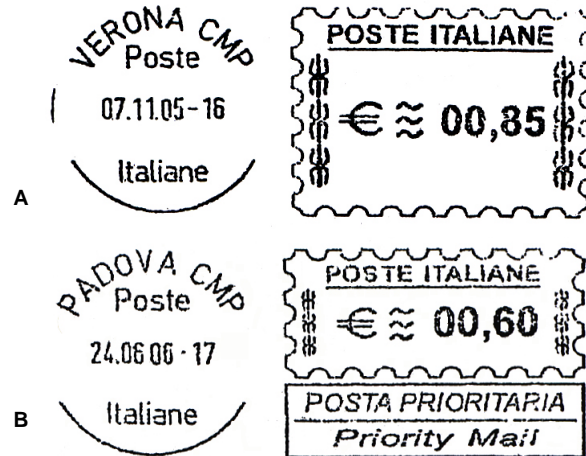

**PO17** 2005, Pitney Bowes (digital). Frank with three chain links at sides as with Sub-group EG. Without meter or identification number. TM with rimless Post Office name at top and arc at bottom "Poste" and "Italiane" horizontal above and below date. Printed in black.

- A. Frank approximately 39 x 28 mm, used for ordinary mail
- B. Short frank approximately 39 x 17 mm with boxed mail classification below, used for Priority and other enhanced classes of mail

**PO18** 2007, unidentified (digital). This stamp appears to be used only for Registered mail.

All examples seen by us have "Postaraccomandata" at top left. Square 2D barcode at right. Value figures at right near top of barcode. In small letters across the bottom are the post code, post office names, date and time.

- A. "Posteitaliane" above 2D barcode, five thick vertical bars at left
- B. "Postaraccomandata" alone across the top, no bars at left

V/F: 0,00

- a. With "AR" slug at top left below "Postaraccomandata", to indicate return receipt requested
